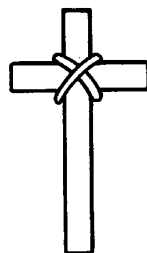

On Sunday 5 July, Her Royal Highness Princess Charlotte, the daughter of the Duke and Duchess of Cambridge, will be christened at St. Mary Magdalene Church on the Sandringham Estate of her great-grandmother, Queen Elizabeth II, and I know many will want to share with me the sense of joy on that occasion.
